She believes the smallest moments carry the most truth, and that grief and joy are rarely separate; they arrive together, tangled, asking to be felt rather than explained. Her stories don't try to resolve pain. They sit with it, the way a good friend would.

More Tales, Same Heart

My Little Love was never meant to be the only story Jude had to tell. It was simply the first one brave enough to be written.

There are more companions waiting in her memory, more places that left their mark, more small moments still asking to become stories. Princess Tutti and Poems and Places are already taking shape. Jude is just getting started.
